Accommodation

The Hungarian Academy of Justice provides and covers the cost of accommodation for the nights 12th and 13th June.

Please note that bookings for additional nights and partners are to be paid by the participant. We accept credit card and HUF in cash. Please note, that we cannot provide meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) after the conference as our kitchen runs only during seminars and events.

The building complex comprises of a conference hall, several training rooms, a library, a hotel, a restaurant and an underground car park (free of charge).

- Room amenities: bathroom, air conditioning, TV, telephone, mini bar, wardrobe
- Bathroom amenities: bathroom with shower, towels, complimentary toiletries, hairdryer
- Other services: sauna and fitness room, iron (can be borrowed at the reception)
- Free WIFI connection is available in the whole building.
- Catering service and reception is provided normally on weekdays only as the Academy is not a standard hotel facility.
