Master Class on Digital Evidence

ICANN – Internet Corporation for Assigned Names and Numbers Case Based Training

<u>ICANN</u> is a not-for-profit organization formed in 1998 that helps coordinate the functioning of the Internet's Domain Name System DNS), coordinates the allocation and assignment of the Internet's unique identifiers, such as Internet Protocol addresses, delegates top-level domains into the global root, and accredits generic top-level domain (gTLD) name registrars.

To reach another person on the Internet you have to type an address into your computer—a name or a number. That address has to be unique so computers know where to find each other. ICANN coordinates these unique identifiers across the world.

DNS records and domain registration information hold invaluable information for law enforcement and judicial authorities. Some of this information is no longer publicly accessible via WHOIS but can be available by following certain processes.

In this training, participants will learn about ICANN, its role, how the domain registration and resolution processes work, through the analysis of the landmark case <u>Operation Avalanche</u>. Participants will also learn about the types of information that are available on the DNS, which can be used as evidence in criminal proceedings.

A follow up training for law enforcement and judicial authorities will be held on the 2nd December with a focus on DDoS attacks.

Both trainings will be Chaired by the EJCN Contact Point for Portugal. The presenter will be Carlos Alvarez del Pino, Director of Trust and Public Safety Engagement from ICANN.
